SEEING STRAY CATS?

FREE* SPAY/NEUTER FOR OUTDOOR COMMUNITY CATS!

Community cats are free-roaming, stray or feral cats who live outdoors in our neighborhoods. We humanely trap, spay or neuter, vaccinate and ear-tip community cats. (Ear-tipping is the universal symbol of a spayed or neutered outdoor cat.) Once they recover, cats are returned to the area where they were originally found, and because they are spayed or neutered, their numbers are reduced over time.

BENEFITS OF SPAY/NEUTER:

- Prevents unwanted litters
- Saves taxpayer money by keeping cats out of municipal shelters
- Decreases the number of cats dying in shelters
- Improves the health of outdoor cats
- Minimizes nuisance behaviors like spraying, fighting, howling and roaming
